

DECLARATION ON THE USE OF CONFLICT MINERALS

On 21st July 2010, the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act was signed into law. The Dodd-Frank Act and related US Securities and Exchange Commission rules require certain companies to disclose the extent to which the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture, contain so called conflict minerals sourced from mines in Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries.

Conflict minerals include Tantalum (Ta), Tin (Sn), Tungsten (W) and Gold (Au), which are used in many products and electronic components.

OLSON ELECTRONICS LIMITED complies with all national and other applicable laws and regulations. As a consequence, we are committed to keeping our supply chain free from conflict minerals which are covered by laws and regulations concerning the sourcing of minerals from conflict areas.

OLSON ELECTRONICS LIMITED will not purchase products that contain conflict minerals, which directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the DRC or adjoining countries.
